Announcement

The Associació del Museu de la Ciència i de la Tècnica i d'Arqueologia Industrial de Catalunya (AMCTAIC) and the scientific committee calls the **XI Jornades d'Arqueologia Industrial de Catalunya**. This workshop, organised every three years, aims to provide and collect new views and original studies on different fields related to Industrial Heritage and its history.

In this occasion, the workshop will be held in **Port Museum of Tarragona**, from 21 to 23 November 2019, entitled "*PORT HERITAGE AND INDUSTRIES LINKED TO THE PORTS*".

Presentation

In history, ports have been spaces sheltered to receive ships, and perform different operations of maritime or fluvial traffic. Currently, ports are fundamentally infrastructures for the transfer of freight and people between land and water transport means.

Thus, we can say that the bases are the infrastructures. Around them we have port buildings and facilities for the loading and unloading. The port attracts direct port industries as a shipbuilding and repair, workshops of the port and other which we find in the port, as in its immediate environment with economic advantages (industries consuming large quantities of raw materials such as steel foundries, refineries, energy industries ...).

Finally, we must highlight as material heritage the broad set of activities carried out by the special vessels on which the Port Authorities now depend, such as maritime signals. In addition, the ports are the stage of a rich and ample intangible heritage.

Thematic and areas

The port and industrial heritage could be classified, following the previous descriptions, in the subsequent topics of study:

- **Infrastructures:** Wharfs, quays, docks, land transport networks (railways, tubes, water, energy supplies to ships, communications)
- **Ports Buildings Storage:** warehouses, silos, open sheds, others.
- **Other Buildings:** official buildings, offices, stations, buildings stations, fishing buildings, nautical club and their facilities, lifesaving stations, customs offices, others.
- **Direct Port Industries:** construction and naval repair, ice factories, industrial refrigerators, others.

- **Industries located in the port area:** refineries, steelworks, gas industries, petrochemicals, basic agro-food industries (wine and alcohols, cereals, refrigerators), others.
- **Machinery for load and unload:** fixed and mobile crane, pallet truck, solid and liquid buck suction machines, conveyor belts, others.
- **Work Boats:** boats removers, (hoists, derricks), bargues, dredgers, practice boats, pilot boats, tugs, others.
- **Maritime signals:** lighthouse, headlights, buoys, bacons, THS or radio stations, others.
- **Intangible Heritage:** different kinds of jobs, professions and labour categories (dockers, seamen, divers, etc. Traditions, lifestyle at the port and maritime legends, religious beliefs, historical memory of other groups, and individual memories of characters.

Papers may also be presented on **other topics on Industrial Heritage**, that will be gathered and presented in a specific section of a general nature: these could be industrial urbanism, study and research methodologies, documentary collections, field work, preservation and safeguard actions.

Call for papers

Proposals could be submitted in three modalities: written paper (it will also be presented orally), poster and video.

Official languages: Catalan, Spanish, English.

The title and summary should be presented before **May 30th, 2019. EXTENDED UNTIL JUNE 20TH, 2019!!!**

Papers not submitted before the deadline will not be included in the program.

Abstracts of oral papers, posters and videos should be a maximum of 30 lines (about 300 words). A brief curriculum of the author or authors must be attached, with a maximum of 5 lines (about 50 words) and the personal information: name and surname, postal address, email and telephone number.

Submissions be sent to the AMCTAIC email secretaria@amctaic.org, including as subject: "Paper - XI Jornades AIC", "Poster - XI Jornades AIC" and "Video - XI Jornades AIC".

The scientific committee will answer all proposals before **June 30th, 2019**, with acceptance, rejection, or suggesting some changes. The scientific committee could recommend the authors on the modality for presentation if needed.

Accepted papers for edition should be sent in **September 30th, 2019**. The details or extension and format will be established by the scientific committee.

During the Congress, the posters and videos will be exhibited in an equipped hall in a specific session.

Lectures and activities

Along the Congress will be celebrated two lectures: An inaugural and a closing lecture. On Saturday 23th, after the academic sessions, there will be activities and visits of sites of industrial heritage. These activities will be announced in the definitive programme.

Registration and modalities

1. Reduced (until October 21, 2019): **80 €** (partners of AMCTAIC, Centers of Studies of Catalonia, IEC (Institut d'Estudis Catalans) and their partners of SCHCT, SCHA and other associations as a TICCHI, INCUNA, entities linked to Industrial Heritage).

2. General (until October 21, 2019): **100 €** (It includes one-year membership to AMCTAIC)

3. Students, senior and unemployed (until October 21, 2019): **50 €** (It is obligatory to send a supporting document). It includes one-year membership to AMCTAIC.

4. From October 22, 2019, a 50% surcharge will be added.

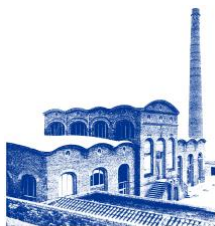
